



Heritage Austin

Summary

As part of a series of downtown initiatives begun in 1997, the City Council supported the development, by the Heritage Society of Austin, of a “community value-based vision” for downtown Austin

Status

The Heritage Society of Austin is rewriting and updating their report *Heritage Austin: A Community Value Based Vision*. This effort will be completed May 15, 2002.

Description

On November 6, 1997, the City Council approved a resolution endorsing the Heritage Austin public input process, and resolving that Heritage Austin serve as an independent planning resource and advisory body to the City Council for downtown Austin, working parallel and in conjunction with the downtown development advisory group.

The Heritage Society is continuing the development of a community value-based vision for the future of Austin’s downtown. The Community Workbook is a “living document” that will continue to change and evolve like the values of the community.
