NSP concentrates on low-to-moderate income neighborhoods and in census tracts with an MFI of 80% or less. Partnering organizations must be non-profits and approved by the City of Austin. The NSP is funded by the City of Austin's Community Development Block Grant, which is made available through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

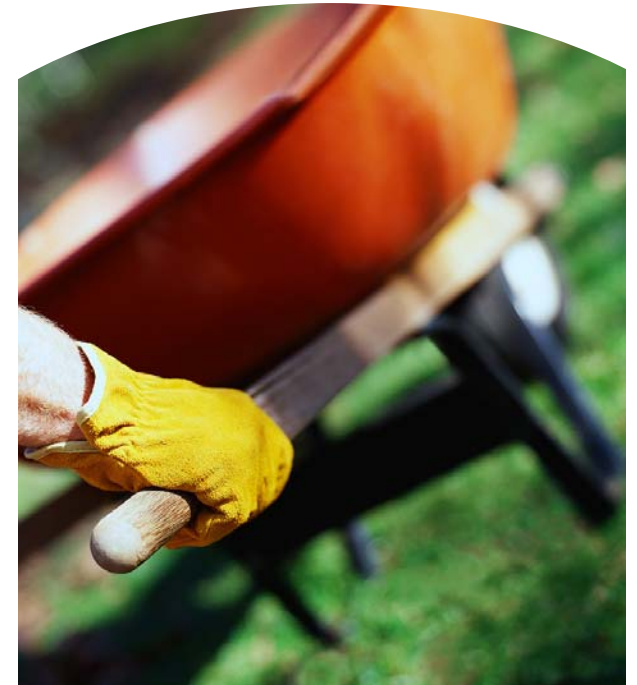
