Shoal Creek Boulevard Re-Striping Options

One Ballot per household

The purpose of this Ballot is to communicate your preferences to City Council.
 Council will make the final decision on which option is selected.
 (Note: Council has directed Staff to remove the curb islands.)

Below are the first and second ranked options for each stakeholder group in the October 15th Stakeholder Meeting: Option 2, Option 3, and two alternative versions of 3. Also attached is a full list of all re-striping options identified.

Please check either #2 or #3:

Option 2: I favor allowing on-street parking on the east curb and car-free bike lanes on both sides. (1' for striping)

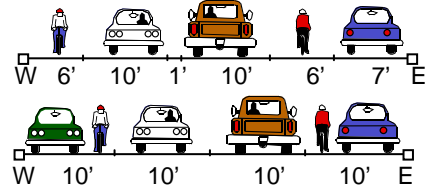
Option 3: I favor keeping the current lanes and striping.
 (Striping dimensions included in lane widths)

If you selected #3, please choose which version you favor:

- 3.** As is
- 3B.*** Same as 3 with the addition of a second white stripe on the outside of the driving lanes to insure shared-use bike-parking lane is not used for a motorist lane.
- 3C.*** Same as 3B with diagonal striping in the shared-use lane.

*(Drivers crossing double white line to park may be ticketed. Texas Traffic laws state: "Crossing is prohibited where there is a pavement marking of double solid white lines.")
