

Shoal Creek Boulevard Re-Striping Options

Please choose one:

- I live on Shoal Creek Boulevard.

Please mark your preferred option (choose one):

- 1. I favor lanes allowing shared use for parking and bikes on both sides.
(I favor allowing parking in the bike lanes.)
- 1A. Same as 1 except each driving lane would be reduced to 10' and 1' rumble stripping would be added along the boundaries between the driving lanes and shared lanes for parking and bikes
- 1B. Same as 1 except addition of grooves in the pavement along the boundaries between the driving lanes and shared lanes for parking and bikes.
- 2. I favor allowing on-street parking on the east curb and car-free bike lanes on both sides.
- 2A. Same as 2 but parking lane is on the west curb instead of the east.
- 2B. Same as 2 but with west curb bike-pedestrian lane 7' wide and 5' bike lane on east side.
- 2C. Same as 2 but with 1 foot of west bike lane taken away to allow buttons to be added to the centerline.
- 2D. Same as 2C except parking on the west curb.
- 3. I favor keeping the current lanes and striping.
- 3A. Same as 3 with the addition of buttons on the lines separating the parking-biking lanes and the driving lanes.
- 3B. Same as 3 with the addition of a second white stripe on the outside of the driving lanes to insure bike-parking lane is not used for a motorist lane.
- 4. I favor parking lanes on both sides with shared lanes for cars and bikes.
- 5. I favor allowing on-street parking on the east curb of the street and a two-way car-free shared-use pedestrian-bike lane on the west side with a small concrete deterrent between the bike-pedestrian lane and the driving lane.
- 5A. Same as 5 except parking on the west curb and car-free shared-use bike-ped facility on the east side.
- 6. No parking lanes; leave one bike lane.
- 7. I favor parking on both sides with a bike lane on one side.
- 8. Double yellow line down the center with no other striping. Allow parking on both sides.
- 9. I favor the original striping on Shoal Creek Boulevard before the resurfacing in 2000.
- 10. I favor a car-free bike lane and parking on the east curb.
