

Buying a new TV? Recycle your old one!

If you decide to recycle your old analog television, the environmentally-friendly recommendation is that you take it to one of the centers that has a “take-back” agreement with the manufacturer of your particular set.

Different centers handle different brands, at little or no charge.

Smaller industrial recycling operations usually charge \$0.25 per lb. or more; they don't always accept individual consumer items, and they tend to use the most economic methods of disposal, which are not always the best from an environmental point of view.
