SURVEYING AND GEOTECHNICAL BORING TO BEGIN NEXT MONTH

Design is underway for the North Acres Wastewater Annexation Project, which will connect the neighborhood to city wastewater services. Residents can expect to see surveyors in the neighborhood soon. In some cases, they will be asking for rights of entry to individual properties. The purpose of obtaining these rights of entry is for surveying only, not for construction. Surveyors must contact property owners before entering properties.

Residents will also see crews in the streets taking ground bore hole samples using a geotechnical engineering drilling rig mounted on a truck. Geotechnical boring is the process of removing cores (samples) of earth to measure groundwater levels and to determine geologic characteristics that will affect project design. Each bore hole will be about five inches in diameter and will be drilled up to about 20 feet deep to remove soil and rock samples for examination and testing in the laboratory. The bore holes will be immediately filled after taking the core samples so to not pose a hazard to traffic or to pedestrians.

Forms were mailed out in the February 2009 Project Update to give residents an opportunity to select a preferred location for wastewater connections.
