





City of Austin Recommended Commercial Irrigation Schedule

(Based on average seasonal rainfall and temperatures)






 Nov - Feb	Off	Test for 2 minutes once a month
 Mar - May	Every 7-14 days	1 start time (50% of summer use)
 Jun - Sep	Twice per week	2 start times
 October	Every 7-14 days	1 start time (50% of summer use)

Spray heads: 5-8 min. per start time Rotor heads: 12-15 min. per start time

Mandatory Year-Round Watering Schedule: Tuesday and/or Fridays
No automatic irrigation between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m.

Customer must update seasonally after initial Water Conservation setup.



-  Increase runtimes only on stations that appear to be dry.
-  Prevent water waste: Check irrigation system monthly.
-  Do not operate with broken heads or leaks (City Code §6-4-63).
-  Adjust your controller seasonally.
-  If it rains for several days, turn it off until the soil dries out.
