Here are some ways you can help keep your creek clean:

- **Keep leaves, grass, paints and other pollutants out of the storm drain.**
- **Pick up pet waste and dispose of it in the trash or toilet**
- **Use fewer fertilizers and chemicals in your yard and NEVER apply yard chemicals before a rain.**
- **Place litter and trash in the garbage.**
- **Fix car leaks.**
- **Dispose of used motor oil, and other car fluids at a local service station drop off center or the Household Hazardous Waste Facility (974-4343). (www.cityofaustin.org/watershed/shadetree)**
- **Use a car wash, or wash your car where the mild or biodegradable soap and water can flow to a non-paved surface.**
