### **Porch:**

1. A covered entrance to a building, usually projecting from the wall and having a separate roof;
2. an open or enclosed gallery or room on the outside of a building; a veranda
3. a portico; a covered walk

### **Portico:**

In architecture, an open space covered by a roof supported on columns, sometimes detached, as a shady walk; in modern usage, a kind of porch before the entrance of a building fronted with columns.

### **Breezeway:**

A covered passageway between a house and garage, sometimes enclosed on the sides.

### **Passageway:**

A narrow way for passage, as a hall, corridor, or alley; a passage.

### **Corridor:** a gallery, corridor, runner

1. in architecture, a gallery or open communication around a building, leading to several chambers at a distance from each other.
2. in fortification, the covered way surrounding the fortifications of a place.
3. a long passageway or hall, especially one on which several rooms open
4. a strip of land forming a passageway between two otherwise separated parts of a country, or between an inland country and a seaport.
